Announcement on the restoration of damages at the Electricity Distribution Network due to the fires

HEDNO announces that all forces continue to work hard for the restoration of the massive damages that have been caused at the Electricity Distribution Network across Greece due to the fires.

In Northern Evoia, where fire and resurgence are still ongoing causing further damages at the Network in the area of Limni-Mantoudi-Agia Anna, 180 out of 800 damaged poles have been replaced and 10km out of the 34km of the damaged Network have also been restored. 10,500 out of the 15,000 affected customers have been reconnected to electricity.

In Istiaia Aidipsos, 10 out of 250 damaged poles have been replaced and 0.5km out of the 12km of the damaged Network have also been restored. 4,000 out of the 6,000 affected customers have been reconnected to electricity.

In the Peloponnese, in the area of Agrinio, works have been completed with 23 poles having been replaced and the 1.85km of the damaged Network having been restored.

In Kalamata, 51 out of 64 damaged poles have been replaced and 7.3km out of the 9.6km of the damaged Network have also been restored. All works have been completed and some individual repairs for certain parts that have extended damages are still pending and will be completed by tomorrow.

In Pirgos, 116 out of 226 damaged poles have been replaced and 12.6km out of the 20.6km of the damaged Network have also been restored. 90% of the accounts have been reconnected to the system with the villages of Nemouta and Pefki as well as some individual accounts still remaining disconnected.

In Sparti, 91 out of 551 damaged poles have been replaced and 10km out of the 44km of the damaged Network have also been restored. 95% of the accounts has been restored, with the villages of Sidirokatsro, Myrsini, Lygera, Konakia, Polyaravos, part of Agios Vasileios and part of Platanio still remaining disconnected. Damages are still being recorded in the area, while most of them cannot be accessed easily.

Finally, in the area of Tripoli, fire is still ongoing, threatening more parts of the Network and constantly causing resurgence. However, the villages of Sari and Vasta have been reconnected to electricity.



In Attica, most accounts in the areas of Tatoe, Kryoneri, Stamata, Afidnai, Malakasa, Vrympompi and Agios Stefanos have been reconnected. Until this evening, we are expecting reconnection for most customers in Drosopigi, Thrakomakedonos and Ippokratios Politeia.

Please note that this morning, the Minister of Environment and Energy, Mr Skrekas, together with the President of HEDNO, Mr N. Bakatselos, CEO A. Manos and Deputy CEO Mr I. Menegatos, the General Secretary for the Financial Policy Mr Chr. Triantopoulos and the RAE Vice president, Mr D. Fournalaris, visited the areas of Attica that have been afflicted to be updated on the progress of the works and watch first-hand the restoration currently carried out.
